- Discussed the vehicle burglaries in Andalucia. There is still property that has not been claimed. If you are still missing property, contact Detective Jim Howell at 247-0455.
- Overall, Apollo Beach is still one of the safest communities to live.

## **2. Citizen Patrol**

- Program continues while meeting goal to free up deputies to do police work and provide a deterrence while driving around the neighborhoods.
- Adding a 6pm to midnight shift is delayed while the program is expanded into other areas. It will happen.

## **3. Manatee Arts Festival - March 8-9**

- This annual festival will be at the new TECO park area at Dickman Road and Noonan Branch Road.

## **4. Radar Display Board**

- Deputy Hill is trying to get one of these display boards for use in Apollo Beach.
- The display of vehicle speeds is a good reminder to drive the speed limit.

## **5. Speed Enforcement**

- Radar checks on Apollo Beach Boulevard and other areas has increased over the past 3-4 months and will continue.

## **6. Detective Jerry Schmidt - Criminal Apprehension Unit**

- Detective Schmidt and 9 other Hillsborough County detectives are responsible for serving warrants throughout the county.
- There are 2 deputies who work on juvenile warrants only.
- There were 42,518 warrants issued in 2007.
- Detectives have 90 days to find the individual and issue the warrant or the warrant is removed from the active list.
