- The number of criminal incidents in July is the lowest in 2008.
- Home burglaries and copper thefts continue to be a problem in the County.
- Cars left unlocked and/or running at convenience are a large source of burglaries.

**2. Deputy Jan Hill has transferred to Patrol and is no longer at the Substation. It's not known if and when that position may be filled due to the HCSO budget cuts.**

**3. 2008 is the 50th Anniversary of Apollo Beach. Events are planned for November 14-16.**

**4. Counterfeit \$100 bills are being passed in the County - be watchful.**

**5. Operation Patriot**

- The annual donations for the Baldomero Lopez Veteran's Home will be collected in November.
- Andalusia residents have been generous in supporting this for the past two years.
- In 2007, enough items were donated in the County to support these veterans for 9 months of the year.

**6. Apollo Beach Nature Park**

- This Park is now closed from 8pm until daylight. Gates are locked so you will have if you don't leave when the park is locked.

**7. Citizens Patrol**

- Program continues to go well with new coverage in Town & Country.
- Attendee asked about covering Covington Park (write letters) and handicap enforcement.

**8. Property Crime - Detective Tom Ellison**

- Have 8 detectives covering pawn shops, career criminals and property crime.
- Only 13% of property crimes are solved and 15% of the stolen property recovered.
- Prevention: lock vehicles, close garage doors, use security system, call in suspicious acts, maintain inventory of jewelry and write down serial numbers of valuable items.
- There are some instances of stolen items being placed on Ebay or Craigs List.
