- Vehicle Stops, Directed Activities and Motorist Assists all increased but these are positive.
- Parking Violation was added as an item for the first time in October - accounts for 16 incidents.
- Burglary-Vehicle, Disturbance, Criminal Mischief and Trespasser/Prowler were all higher than the 10 month

average.

- Andalusia had one Trespasser incident in October.
- Residents need to lock car doors and keep garage door openers and valuables out of sight.

**6. DUI Prevention/Enforcement Presentation - Deputy Mika McDowell**

- Statistics:

There was a DUI fatality every 31 minutes in Florida in 2005.

Since 2001, there have been over 3,000 fatalities involving DUI in Florida.

From 1982 to 2005 - there were over 45,000 fatalities due to DUI in Florida.

Florida is ranked 2nd in DUI fatalities (California is 1st).

- The average cost to fight a DUI charge in court is \$6,000 - \$10,000 for the individual.
- Three DUI's in 10 years results in a felony charge.
- After a second DUI, the driver can be required to install a breathalyzer interlock in his/her car.
- The blood alcohol limit in Florida is 0.08 - same as all states in the Country.
- The number of drinks to reach the limit varies with weight but can be 3-4 beers or alcoholic drinks.
- If you observe an impaired driver, contact the Sheriff's office at 247-8200 (non-emergency number).
- If you have a party, you are responsible for guests who drink too much.
