1. Criminal/Activity Report

- Thefts, Alarm Reports, Suspicious Persons and Criminal Mischief are the only incidents that were higher in May than the average for the first five months of 2007.
- The 178 Criminal/Activity incidents is the lowest number this year. This includes 73 vehicle stops which are positive prevention incidents.

2. Apollo Beach Wins Award

- The Apollo Beach Community Resource Area won a certificate for the lowest number of reported crimes of all areas in the County.
- This is the first time Apollo Beach has won the award in three years.

3. Citizen Patrol

- Mike Wall provided information to the group on the objective and activities of the Citizen Patrol.

- 4. Lt. Andy Ross, District 4 Night Commander, spoke to the group about current activities.

- The HCSO has been tasked with making a significant reduction in their expense budget.
- Where possible, residents of Apollo Beach should speak out to not cut important services that the deputies perform for us.

5. Captain Marsicano has been promoted to lead District 4 after the retirement of Major York. Lt. Hartley will replace Captain Marsicano.

- Promotions are effective on July 16, 2007.

6. Joan Noble, Coordinator - SouthShore Community Justice Center - Community Mediation

- Ms. Noble spoke to the group about Community Mediation which is a service provided by the County.

- Both parties must agree to mediation and they make the decision on how the issue is resolved.

- The Mediator acts as a facilitator to attempt to reach a resolution.

- Mediation can be provided for Consumer, Contract, Employer/Employee, Family Conflicts, Homeowner/HOA, Landlord/Tenant, Money Owed, Neighbor Conflicts, Unsatisfactory Service and Animal Nuisance issues.

- This is a free service.

- 70% of issues brought to mediation are successfully resolved.
