2. State of Florida Emergency Contact Information Database

- Florida drivers can input up to three phone numbers and two people they want to be contacted in the event of an emergency.
- This database is secure and not accessible by anyone other than those authorized.

3. Sex Offender / Predator Roundup

- HCSO deputies personally check on all sex offender/predators every six months.
- This was accomplished on Friday, December 1.

4. The Apollo Beach Sheriff's Substation (by Publix) is a dropoff location for the Toys for Tots program.

5. New Home Security Risk - Bump Keys

- Deputy Hill advised that individuals can go on the internet and order "bump keys" for about \$20.
- These keys can be stuck into a door lock and an impression made that allows you to open the door.
- Residents should be aware of this recent development although there have been few incidents at this time.

6. The HCSO will be focusing on traffic violation stops in December - especially at high schools

7. The Chamber of Commerce representative advised that the concrete block "Apollo Beach" sign that was damaged will probably not be restored. This is a private sign that is not owned by Apollo Beach.

8. Deputy Theresa Montaldo - School Resource Officer - Beth Shields School

- There is a School Resource Officer at every County middle and high school.
- The SRO teaches students at least 12 hours/months on subjects like bike safety, gang activity, career opportunities, etc.
