2. Sun City Center Burglaries
  - There were a series of "smash and grab" incidents in the past few weeks.
  - One of two suspected gangs have been arrested.
3. Mira Bay Neighborhood Watch
  - While the crime rate low, Mira Bay is forming a Neighborhood Watch group in their community.
4. 8/25 - "Celebrate the Children" - Calvary Lutheran Church - 11am to 4pm
  - Calvary Lutheran is hosting this program which all children are invited to attend.
  - Volunteers will be needed to help out if you're interested.
5. 9/21 - Easter Seal Fund Raiser
  - Century 21 is hosting
6. 9/22 - Bike Rodeo - Doby Elementary - Covington Park - 10am to 2pm
  - All children are invited
  - Volunteer help will be needed if you're interested.
7. Citizen Patrol
  - The next class of CP volunteers begins on 8/13.
  - You should be seeing the Citizen Patrol car in Apollo Beach and Andalucia. Stop and talk to them if you have any questions.
8. Environmental - Detective Shannon Locke
  - Detective Locke discussed this department that works closely with other agencies on dumping, solid waste, environmental protection and code enforcement.
  - Fines for illegal dumping on County right-of-way:
    - Less than 15 pounds > \$150 Citation
    - 16 pounds to 499 pounds > Misdemeanor
    - Over 500 pounds > Felony
  - If you see illegal dumping, get information on vehicle, license plate number, etc. - don't put yourself at risk.
  - Putting personal trash into private dumpsters is a misdemeanor.
  - Communicate this information to your family and friends. Violations are taken seriously.
