2. Recognition - Apollo Beach was recognized for having the second lowest crime rate in November, 2006.

3. Sheriff's Town Hall Meeting - March 29 - Lennard High School

- Meeting is an opportunity to hear what's happening in Hillsborough County and ask questions.
- 6-7pm - Sheriff's Informational and Tactical Equipment Displays.
- 7-8:30pm - Town Hall Meeting

4. Citizen Patrol

- Graduation of 24 volunteers in this pilot program was on March 5 (15 of these will patrol Apollo Beach).
- Citizen Patrol members will assist deputies and perform traffic direction, vacation checks, crossing guard duty, etc.
- Mike Wall is a participant in this program and you can contact him for more information.

5. Manatee Arts Festival - Will be held on Saturday, March 10.

6. Relay for Life - Relay teams will walk continuously on 3/30-31/07 to raise money for cancer research.

- \$27,000 was raised in 2006 and the 2007 goal is \$30,000.

7. May - National Law Enforcement Appreciation Month

- There will be a bicycle ride from Virginia to Washington DC.
- Money is being solicited (tax deductible) to pay for spouses and children of fallen officers to attend the event.

8. Crisis Management - Detective Danny Johnson

- Presented information about the HCSO Crisis Management Team.
- 11 deputies are trained negotiators and perform this along with their normal duties.
- Program begun in mid-80's after SWAT was implemented.
- Success rate has been 98%-99%.
