1. Criminal/Activity Incident Report

- The number of incidents in June increased significantly over May (85) even though there were only 30 days in the month.
- Vehicle Stops and Directed Activity accounted for 56 of the increase and these are preventive activities.
- There were increases in Criminal Mischief, Trespasser/Prowler, Drug Violation and Disturbance incidents.

## 2. Pilar's Harbour Condominiums - Apollo Beach Boulevard (Under Rehabilitation)

- The placement of the new garages close to the sidewalk were submitted and approved.
- Contractors are placing vehicles and building material on the sidewalk which impedes walkers and joggers. Deputy Hill has observed this and is working with the contractors to improve this condition.

## 3. Graffiti

- The number of graffiti incidents (Criminal Mischief ) is on the rise particular on Miller Mac and Flamingo.
- Deputies and Citizen Patrol will be observing these areas.
- Citizens need to report anything they see to the HCSO.

## 4. Citizen Patrol

- This volunteer patrol continues to be active within Apollo Beach.
- Another class of volunteers will begin in a few weeks.

## 5. Code Enforcement - Officers Acevedo and Rentas

- Code Enforcement made a presentation to the Community Council.
- They enforce community standards, public health and safety issues.
- The requirement is to investigate any complaint within 7 days.
- A property owner can be cited if their property has uncorrected graffiti on it - it's their responsibility.
- It is illegal to park a 1-ton or greater truck or trailer on residentially zoned property if the truck/trailer is used commercially.
