- CIS is a contract security service that provides anti-terrorism and other support.
- CIS provides Anti-Terrorism Officers at the TECO plant and other power plants in the country.
- There are numerous video cameras located on the TECO property including the manatee viewing area and there is continuous monitoring of activities.
- Taking photographs of the power plant is illegal.
- The Coast Guard monitors water access in the restricted area on the west side of the plant.
